**Please return the self-evaluation forms that were distributed at the beginning of Winter Quarter. Give to Betty Ann.

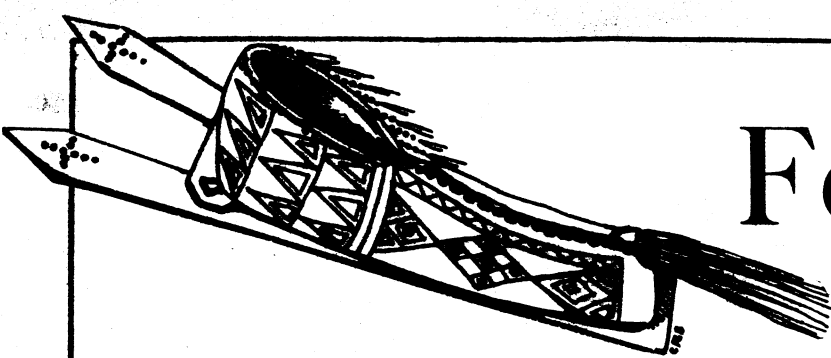
**How goes the studies? Keeping that 15 unit B average maintained?
